## **Flatwater North School Programs**

Half-Day Program (Maximum of one class per session or 30 people – See attached Department of Education Standards)

Grades: 2 - 12 – Dragon Boating

5 – 12 – Tandem Canoeing, Stand-Up paddle boarding, Kayaking **Time:** 9:30 am - 11:30 am / 12:30 pm - 2:30 pm **Location:** Schwatka Lake Day Use Area (km 3.4 on the Chadburn Lake Rd) **Price:** \$300 **Includes:** Two qualified instructors, PFD's, paddles, boats, safety equipment, learning and fun! **Instruction:** Focus will be on the canoe strokes using the dragon boat and tandem canoes.

Half-day groups are welcome to stay on site for lunch prior or after their session.

Full Day Program: (Maximum of one class per session or 30 people – See attached Department of Education Standards)

Grades: 2 - 12 – Dragon Boating

5 – 12 – Tandem Canoeing, Stand-Up paddle boarding, Kayaking

Time: 9:30 am - 2:30 pm
Location: Schwatka Lake Day Use Area (km 3.4 on the Chadburn Lake Rd)
Price: \$600
Includes: Two qualified instructors, PFD's, paddles, boats, safety equipment, learning and fun!
Instruction: Depending on the grade level, students will be taught the differences between a variety of different water crafts (canoes, kayaks, SUP's and dragon boat) and get a chance to paddle them. They will also learn about parts of the boats, water safety, and the different paddling strokes using games and teamwork.

Due to the nature of our sport, you will be exposed to the cold water and potentially bad weather. Please dress accordingly, avoid cotton clothing, and in dress in layers. There are portable toilets on site, change rooms and a water cooler available for water bottle refills. We recommend participants bring the following:

- Swim suit and towel
- Warm clothes (long pants, warm sweatshirt, jacket)
- Extra set (or two) of dry clothes

- Water shoes or sandals and running shoes
- Hat, sunscreen and sunglasses
- Rain jacket

In case of extreme weather, groups can reschedule on the next available day or be refunded in full.

Participants must have waiver signed by parent or guardian. Teachers, must ensure that the waivers are completed before arriving on site.
